

Colored-Ice Snowman Decorations

MATERIALS

- Food coloring or liquid watercolors
- Water
- Ice cube trays, bowls, cake pans, muffin tins
- Latex or vinyl gloves
- Freezer
- A snowman (or woman, cat, etc.)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill bowls, muffin tins, etc. with water. Mix in food coloring. Freeze.
2. Fill gloves at the tap, add a squirt or two of food coloring, and tie. Freeze. (Note: To make arms for the gloves, insert a stick in the glove of colored water and tie a string tightly around the wrist before freezing.)
3. When you are ready to use your colored ice decorations, set the pans in a sink of warm water just until the ice is loosened enough to come out. Invert over a bowl or basin. To remove gloves from ice hands, carefully snip and peel off.
4. Use colored ice to create eyes, nose, hat, hands, buttons, and other decorations for your snowman.
